

COVID-19 INCIDENT RESPONSE

IF YOU HAVE SOMEONE WITH COVID-19 SYMPTOMS AT YOUR SPORT EVENT?

- Fever
- Cough
- Colds
- Headache
- Diarrhea
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Joint and Muscle Pain

IF YOU HAVE SOMEONE EXPOSED TO COVID-19 AT YOUR SPORT EVENT?

- Travelled to other countries in the past 14 days
- Exposure to a confirmed COVID-19 patient
- Travelled to, reside, or worked in another state area with reported COVID-19 cases
- Exposure to a person under investigation for COVID-19

If someone wth COVID-19 has been at your event - ring the Hotline 24/7 on 1800 020 080 and follow the advice

With Exposure + With Symptoms:

- Immediate: Isolate the person from others and keep them safe.
- If school student, with no other illnesses and mild symptoms: contact Parents, send home/quarantine, seek medical assessment.
- If young (<70 years old), with no other illnesses and mild symptoms: send home/quarantine, seek medical assessment.
- If elderly (>70 years old), with symptoms: Seek urgent medical assistance.
- High Risk People: Anyone with a weakened immune system or chronic disease i.e. respiratory, cardiovascular, cancer, kidney, diabetes, liver. Seek urgent medical assistance.

With Exposure + No Symptoms:

- Immediate: Isolate the person from others and keep them safe.
- If school student: contact Parents, send home/quarantine, seek medical assessment.
- Other people: send home/quarantine, advise seek medical assessment and should symptoms start to develop seek medical attention.

No Exposure + With Symptoms:

- Immediate: Isolate the person from others and keep them safe.
- If school student, with no other illnesses and mild symptoms: contact Parents, send home, seek medical assessment.
- Other people: Send home, manage symptoms accordingly.
 Advise seek medical assessment.
