The ACC only uses manual judging as a manual back up of places in case of complete automated timing system failure. Currently only one adult Place Judge official and one student assistant are used for the role. This Place Judge records the places of all competitors for each race and confirms with the Chief Referee what the manual places will be. The places are then recorded on their manual check sheet (see next page). Record the lane numbers in order of the place achieved e.g. 4, 7, 2, 5, 3, 1, 6, 8 (i.e. 1st lane 4, 2nd lane 7, 3rd lane 2, 4th lane 5, 5th lane 3, 6th lane 1, 7th lane 6, 8th lane 8).

The result awarded by the manual Place Judge will only be used for the official results in situations where the automatic timing system fails or there is a protest dispute.

Place Judges should be placed at least five metres from, and in line with the finish line, in order that they may have a good view of the finish line (elevated)

The Place Judge shall record the placings for each lane and record this on the sheet provided in their file. If there has been an automatic timing system failure an ACC official will approach the Place Judge and ask for the manual places recorded for an event or series of events. At the conclusion of the carnival the Place Judge is to return the completed place sheet to the ACC results official, do not leave the sheet in the file. The Referee shall liaise with the Place Judge. The Referee is in control of all pool officials. If there is a dispute on any placing, it is only the Referee that may decide the placings, but the Referee does not have power to alter placings if the Judge agrees on their placings. The Referee should stand in line with the finish line and also assist in the place judging process.

Place Judge's Personal check sheet

The *Place Judge Check Sheets* are division specific. An example is below.

Record the LANE numbers in order of the place achieved i.e., 4, 7, 2, etc.
