

# ACC Championship Soccer One Day Carnival - Rules

2025

Associated and Catholic Colleges (ACC) and Football West reserve the right to cancel, change or amend any or all parts of this format leading up to and on the day including playing times and the fixtures. The ACC endeavours to uphold the Associations Motto of 'Sport in the Right Spirit' in all stages of planning and running of this competition.

## 2025 SET UP SCHOOLS:

Venue: Lark Hill Sportsplex – **South Coast Baptist** (arrive 8.15am)

Venue: Forrestfield United Fields – **St Norbert** (arrive 8.15am)

Venue: Kingsway Regional Sporting Complex – **St Andrew's** (arrive 8.15am)

Venue: Mercy College, Koondoola – **Mercy College (host school)**

*(Field set requires goals in place, nets on goals and corner flags on all fields)*

## MORNING BRIEFING - COACH, CAPTAIN & REFEREES

Will occur approximately 20 minutes prior to Rd 1 kick off in a central location at all venues i.e. verandah, field 1

## TIMING

Central timing will be used for all fields at all venues. All rounds will start on time; coaches are expected to have their teams briefed and ready to play on field in position before the starting siren/horn.

## REFEREES

Accredited soccer central referees will be sourced by the ACC. Each school will be invoiced after the carnival for this shared referee cost. Each team must supply a competent sideline referee with a sideline flag so that both sidelines are covered during each game. The sideline referee should have a vest or uniform different to the team and have a general understanding of the soccer offside rules.

## FORMAT

All fixtures will be 2 x 17 minute halves / 5 minute half time / 11 minute changeover.

## SCORECARDS

Scorecards are to be signed and completed by the referee of each fixture.

## TOILETS/CHANGEROOMS

Toilets are made available at all venues.

## DRINKS / FOOD

Responsibility of each team. Water fountains or taps are available at the venues. Students should be advised to bring a packed lunch and eat during the small intervals between rounds or when the team has a scheduled bye.

## WARM UP & GAME BALLS

Teams should arrive 30 minutes prior and warm up on their allocated round 1 field. Teams must bring their own warm up and game balls. Referee will select the best game ball for usage during the game. Size 5 soccer balls.

## FIRST AID

St John Ambulance will be available at all venues (organised and booked by the ACC)

## POST GAME

Acknowledgements will commence immediately following the final round of fixtures. All players, coaches and referees are invited to move to designated point (TBC) for acknowledgement asap after the final game.

## TEAM STAFFING

Teams must be supervised by a suitable experienced adult/teacher assigned in a coaching or manager role. Schools must understand their "Duty of Care" and ensure the presence of staff at the venue (as applicable).

## **SQUAD / TEAM PLAYING NUMBERS**

ACC member schools may enter (1) soccer team in each gender. Senior Championship soccer teams are made up of open age players, generally senior team classification includes predominantly students in Year 10-12. Soccer squads up to a maximum of 18 players with 11 on field (7 substitute players) are permitted.

## **INTERCHANGE / SUBSTITUTION**

Substitution must be made through the central referee and should be made at the end of each half or a stoppage i.e. injury or sideline throw. Interchange rules apply to the philosophy of participation and not to be used for time wasting. There are to be no substitutions (unless a player is injured) in the final 3 minutes of each half to ensure the game is played in the right spirit. Being a one-day carnival with many games, players being substituted off can return to the field (player can be substituted on/off).

## **UNIFORMS**

For all Championship games, players dress standards must be consistent with, and in line with the usual expectations for that sport and be the official team uniform for that school. Numbered playing tops should be worn by players for identification. The captain of the team should also wear a clear and distinguished arm band that identifies them to the referees. Tracksuits are NOT acceptable items to be worn during games unless it is the goalkeeper. All teams to ensure they bring an alternative set of tops/vests or bibs in the event of a uniform clash.

## **EVENT RULES**

Rules are in accordance with Football Federation Australia junior rules unless otherwise stated. Start and End of game acknowledgements: at the completion of games each team captain will call their team to give three cheers to the opposition team.

## **POINTS FOR GAMES**

3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw, 0 points for a loss. 3 points for forfeit win, 0 points for a forfeit (5-0 score). In the case of a draw, teams are to immediately move to sudden death penalties (no extra time – see below). Adequate time for this within the fixture breaks prior to the next round getting underway. Forfeits should be avoided.

## **MAXIMUM MARGIN – 5 Goals (capped result).**

This is a similar enactment to the “mercy rule” where the maximum margin recorded in the game will be capped at 5 goals. This ensures that teams can then rotate players to ensure all players get more game time when the maximum margin has been met and final score recorded.

## **PENALTIES / EXTRA TIME**

Should scores be tied at full time (i.e. 1-1) the game immediately moves into penalties. Each team will take one for one sudden death penalties (not 5 and 5) until a goal is missed and winning team defined. The draw will be the official final result (each team awarded 1 point each on the ladder). However, the penalties may be called upon to help define the two teams should they be tied in the final ladder standings at the end of the preliminary pool rounds, including each team having equal goal for / against differential.

## **LADDER STANDINGS**

Ladder standings are firstly determined by Total Points (i.e. 3 wins = 9 points), then secondly by Goal Differential (goals scored minus goals against). If two teams are tied on Total Points & Goal Differential, the result will be determined by which team won the head-to-head (this may have been via the sudden death penalties). Finally, if – 3 teams are tied equal top on the ladder standings and goal differential, in game goals scored (offensive) will be weighted as double. Highest scoring offensive team across the carnival will be placed highest.

## **COMPETITION STRUCTURE**

Teams have been placed into preliminary pools – One Day Carnival Pools and Sub Association groups. After the completion of the pools, the winning teams will be elevated into the elimination championship finals bracket that operates during Term 3 (Week 1-6).
