

ACC Championship Basketball Classic – Information

2026

Associated and Catholic Colleges (ACC) and Basketball WA (BWA) reserve the right to cancel, change or amend any or all parts of this format leading up to and on the day including playing times and the fixtures. The ACC endeavours to uphold the Associations Motto of 'Sport in the Right Spirit' in all stages of planning and running of this competition.

Duration and Start of Play

- 1.1 **Game schedule pending nominations / venues for either.** Schedule will run between 9.30am and 2.30pm (carnival day fixtures)
 - a) two (2) x 12-minute halves with a two (2) minute break at half time. A nine (9) minute period is allocated between games before the next fixture begins.
 - b) two (2) x 12-minute halves with a one (1) minute break at half time. A five (5) minute period is allocated between games before the next fixture begins (*Regional Junior only*)
 - c) two (2) x 15-minute halves with a (3) minute break at half time. A twelve (12) minute period is allocated between games before the next fixture.
- 1.2 All fixtures will be on a running **central clock with no time stoppages.**
- 1.3 **One-60 second time-out per team, per half** will be allowed during which the clock will NOT stop.
- 1.4 **No time-outs will be allowed in the final (3) minutes of either half.** *If a time out is called with 3.40 left this will only permit a 40 second time out to ensure the final 3 minutes is played.*
- 1.5 **Imperative games begin on time to enable the fixture to run to schedule.** It is the school's responsibility to be on the correct court at the correct time to start play. Round 1 games must start prior to half time. If a team arrives at or after half time, the fixture will be forfeited, however both teams can play a friendly (no result game) in the second half.
- 1.6 **A jump ball will commence the game** and subsequent referee called contests will be decided by a possession arrow – alternate between teams.
- 1.7 **Substitutions can only be called during stoppages of play (i.e. fouls & out of bounds),** this does not include after a score from either team.

Fouls

- 2.1 **2 x 12-minute halves (Fouls):** Each team is allowed 4 fouls per half before the two-shot penalty is applied. Any player receiving five (5) fouls during a game will be fouled out and must be substituted. The player cannot take any further part in the game; however, they are eligible to play the next fixture / round.
- 2.2 **2 x 15-minute halves (Fouls):** each team is allowed 5 fouls per half before the two-shot penalty is applied. Any player receiving five (5) fouls during a game will be fouled out and must be substituted. The player cannot take any further part in the game; however, they are eligible to play the next fixture / round.

Conditions of Play

- 3.1 **Maximum squad size is set at 12 players per team.** Minimum number of players is 5.
- 3.2 **Each team is to nominate one competent official to be on the score bench for each game.** This can be a teacher, parent, or competent senior student (who is not playing the game in progress). It is highly recommended that the person assisting has knowledge of basic stadium electronic scoring and generic basketball paper scorecards.
- 3.3 **Game Ball: Senior/Junior Boys are to use size 7 ball. Senior /Junior Girls will use Size 6 Ball.** Teams should arrive 30 minutes prior and warm up on their allocated Round 1 court. Teams must bring their own warm-up and game balls. Referees will select the best quality match ball to start.
- 3.4 **Maximum Margin – 30 points (capped result).** This is an action in line with the "mercy rule" where the maximum margin recorded in the game will be 30 points. When the 30 point margin is reached, scoring ceases. No further score recording will take place at the scorebench. The game can continue and this ensures that teams can then rotate players to ensure all players get more court time and enjoyment when the maximum margin has been reached. Example 44-14 (capped).
- 3.5 **No Draws – Golden Point:** If scores are level at full time, the game immediately resets to a centre court jump ball and the game continues without clock until the next point is scored (to break the tied deadlock). This can be a single point i.e. foul/penalty shot
- 3.6 General rules are in accordance with Basketball Australia junior rules, unless stated otherwise in the ACC Operations Manual. Three (3) seconds in the key, cross court centre line violation and eight (8) seconds in the back court all apply.

- 3.7 Regulation basketball court of 28m x 15m to be used. Lines should be well marked and court surface safe of any hazards. Basketball rings should be set regulation height (3.05m).

Ladder and Points

- 4.1 **Ladder: 4 points awarded for a win and 1 point for a loss.** Forfeiting team will receive 0 points for a loss.
- 4.2 Should two, or more, teams achieve the same total ladder points at the end of the round robin games the finishing position will be determined by:
- Firstly, determined by points differential (points for / points against differential).
 - The second differential measure will be the head-to-head game result between the tied teams. Teams cannot have a "draw" as per point 3.5 above.
 - If three (3) teams are still tied after this point the highest scoring offensive team (total points for) will decide the final order (placing).
- 4.3 The referee will approve the final score before the result is valid (i.e. sign scoresheet)
- 4.4 The finishing order determines which teams qualify into the Elimination finals.

Playing Uniforms and Numbering

- 5.1 The ACC strongly recommends all players wearing mouthguards on court. Schools must take full responsibility of any students choosing not to wear mouthguards.
- 5.2 Schools are requested to wear an appropriate basketball uniform. If no basketball playing uniform is being used, teams must wear school sports/PE uniform with numbered bibs/vests.
- 5.3 Should uniforms not allow numbers to be placed on them then all players will be asked to have clearly visible numbers written on their arms.
- 5.4 In accordance with the FIBA rules, teams may only use numbers 0, 00 and 1 to 99.
- 5.5 Players on the same team cannot wear duplicate numbers.
- 5.6 Shorts should not have pockets and if worn, pockets will be required to be taped down for safety reasons.
- 5.7 All players must remove jewellery such as earrings and rings. Piercings can be dangerous and may require tape over the top.

Toilets/Changerooms

- 6.1 Toilets and changerroom facilities are available at each venue. The changerrooms should not be used for team congregations or team meetings.

Drinks/Food

- 7.1 Responsibility of each team. Some venues will have a kiosk or café that may be open for light refreshments. Players should prepare a packed lunch/snacks and eat during fixture intervals or bye fixtures.
- 7.2 Drink fountains are available at each venue (refilling drink bottles).

First Aid

- 8.1 All schools to bring their own personal first aid kits for minor incidents and player strapping. ACC will provide hired first aid personnel at Qualification Carnivals for first aid treatment and injury concerns.

Presentations

- 9.1 A short acknowledgment and thankyou will be hosted by the Carnival Manager following Qualification carnivals (allow approximately 5-10 minutes)
- Players and Staff
 - Referees
 - Venue /First Aid
- 9.2 This will be hosted in a central position such as Court 1, Foyer and or Grandstand.
- 9.3 Announcement of winning teams that will progress in the ACC Championship.



