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1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

COST	Costs for the day will be shared amongst participating schools, which include (but are not limited to) venue hire, First Aid, BBQ lunch, medallions and marquee hire.

PARTNERSHIP

The ACC Multi Sport Day is in partnership with State Sporting Associations (SSA), whose staff deliver the activity rotations and all equipment required to do so.

2.0 NOMINATION OF STUDENTS

Any student with a disability (Years 7 to 12), whether enrolled in an Education Support unit or not, is eligible to attend.

3.0 SUPERVISION

- Schools nominating students must make arrangements for adequate supervision and ensure adequate number of staff are available to supervise all student, across their activity groups
- Supervising staff are required to assist with students needs throughout the day.

4.0 FIRST AID

- The ACC will provide St John Ambulance First Aid for the event
- Students receiving First Aid care **must** be under the supervision of a staff member, so that relevant case history and specific needs are communicated.

5.0 SPECTATORS

Spectators are to be supervised by staff at all times.

6.0 MARQUEES AND WEATHER

- Schools are encouraged to source their own provisions for shade/shelter/protection. Marquees and / or ground tarpaulins are to be set-up by schools prior to event start.
- A small number of marquees will be provided by John XXIII College for use on the day, however there are not sufficient to cater for all
- **If schools maintenance / ground staff are delivering and setting up shelter prior to the event, ACC staff must be notified at least one week prior to the event**
- In the event the forecast for the day is inclement weather, the ACC will SMS all school Inclusive Coordinators representatives by 8am of the morning of the event.

7.0 FORMAT OF THE DAY

- On closure of nominations, students are placed activity groups, with students from other attending schools.
- Group and rotation information is provided within the event day program which will be circulated to all attending schools pre event, and will also be displayed on station signs and across the grounds
- After the event welcome, staff are organise students into their predetermined groups and directed to each of their numbered bays
- SSA staff will collect their relevant group, and activity sessions will commence
- The fundamentals of each sport will be introduced to students for each activity station, leading into a series of fun, engaging games, designed to encourage participation
- Students will not experience all sports due to the time frame, number of attendees and SSA present
- To ensure the participant to SSA staff ratio is maintained, staff are asked **NOT TO MOVE** multiple students across groups.
- Activity stations run for a 20 minute duration, with a 5 minute transition period, all of which is signalled with an air horn
