# 3.0 Ten Pin bowling information

**TIME** 11:00 - 13:30 (First game 11:30)

(\*\*Schools are encouraged to arrive no later than 15 minutes prior for shoe distribution etc. Unless a specific arrival time is provided to you from the venue\*\*)

#### **TEN PIN BOWLING COST**

- Schools will be invoiced by the ACC for the number of students nominated (final numbers confirmed by schools three days before the event). The cost for two games is \$21.90 per student.
- School and student lane allocations will be organised before the day based on nominations. Please note in nominations if you have specific student groupings you would like.
- A maximum of 70 students can attend the bowling at each venue and <u>nominations/places will be</u> <u>assigned on a first in basis.</u>

- Schools can nominate students to play & pay for one game or two games, or a combination. Most years
  schools pay for two games, as reasonably able students will complete 1 game well within a 2 hour time
  frame and they should consider playing 2 games.
- Schools can select which venue they would like to attend. If a venue is full schools will be allocated to the other venue.
- Bowling lane bumpers and disabled ramps will be provided.
- Please phone Zone Bowling Morley or <del>Joondalup</del> Cannington for further information about the venue including food options and student requirements. Note: Each centre has varying policies in regard to consumption of foods.

#### **FORMAT**

- Tennis West will be supporting and delivering a split of both tabloid games and a 'tournament' at this tennis carnival
- Schools will be able to nominate which of their students will be participating in tabloid games, and which will compete in the a round robin modified tennis tournament

## 5.0 Nomination of students

The events are open to all students and are targeted at students with a disability regardless of whether they are enrolled in and education support unit or not.

Ten Pin Bowling Nominations are to be received by the ACC office no later than: Wednesday 1st November

No late nominations will be accepted.

Nominations are to be submitted online via a web form on the ACC website by completing the required information:

- Venue to attend
- Number of games to be played (relevant to Ten Pin bowling only)
- Student names
- Year Group
- Special Needs (needs ramp etc...)

Please Note: Any special grouping requests must me noted on the nomination form

Student names MUST be included on the nomination form so that suitable provisions can be made.

# 6.0 Supervision

Schools nominating students must make arrangements for adequate supervision. At least one staff member per 5 students is required.

School supervising staff are required to assist with bowling and scoring. Scoring is optional and at the discretion of staff supervisors.

#### 6.0 First Aid

Injuries are to be attended to by the individual school staff. Assistance is also available from the facility staff that have a first aid kit. Students receiving First Aid care from facility staff **must** be under the supervision of a staff member that their relevant case history and specific needs are communicated to the facility staff.

# 7.0 Spectators

Spectators are to be supervised by staff at all times and are to be kept well clear of the bowling lanes event activities.

# 8.0 Bowling Lane & tennis group allocations

Each student nominated by his or her school will be allocated to a particular bowling lane (if bowling) or tennis group (if participating in the tennis carnival). Where possible students will bowl participate in activities with and against students from other schools.

\*\*Please note in your nomination if you would like students grouped together or separated\*\*

# 9.0 COVID-19 Safety Procedures

All students, staff, coaches, officials, and other personnel are asked to follow the COVID-19 safety rules to keep everyone safe:

#### **Equipment**

No sharing of personal items such as water bottles, towels or clothing is permitted.

#### **Physical Distancing**

 Schools should maintain a strict limit of a minimum of 1.5 square metres (1.5sqm) per person where practicable.

#### **Good Hygiene**

- Schools to provide hand sanitisation for students.
- Schools to promote importance of personal hygiene to students; hand cleaning, no physical
  greeting contact (i.e., handshakes, high 5's, hugs, physical performance celebrations), no spitting,
  cough and sneeze covering.

#### **If you are Feeling Unwell**


- Students should report any cold or flu symptoms to a staff member if they are feeling unwell.
- People feeling unwell and showing flu/cold like symptoms will be isolated from other people and arrangements made for them to leave the venue ASAP.

### **Covid Impact Statement**

• If schools are closed, or there are significant staff/student absences due to COVID, ACC events will be impacted. Events may be cancelled, or schools/teams withdrawn. If the event becomes unviable, ACC will cancel and notify all schools.
